- Tenon saw
- Hammer
- Quick action clamps x 4
- Sash clamps x 3
- Sanding cork
- Handplane
- Jigsaw
- Belt sander
- Router and 6mm rounding over and 6mm grooving bits
- Mitre saw
- Biscuit machine
